GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS SUBMISSION POSTER & VIDEO

Abstracts must be submitted online at: www.admedic.pt

Deadline for Abstract Submission: September 26th, 2022

All abstracts must be submitted and presented in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication.

Papers may only submit original material, not published or presented prior to the Symposium, and should be structured by the following criteria:

- Introduction
- Goals
- Methods
- Results
- Discussion/Conclusions

After abstracts evaluation by the scientific committee, authors will be notified by email, communicating the approval or exclusion of the abstract.

All fields requested in the form must be filled in.

- Title: Must be in capital letter (maximum 100 characters);
- Text of the Abstract: Limited to 3500 characters (maximum) including spaces, but not including the title, authors, and institutions;
- Affiliation: Indicate the name of the Institution to which the authors are affiliated;
- Name of Authors: The name of the presenter should be indicated first.

Abstracts will not be published if the Presenter is not registered until October 24th.

Abstracts will be considered for poster presentations.

Do not hesitate to contact the secretariat, should you have any queries or need additional information or help.

VERY IMPORTANT | When uploading your abstract please choose the status: **DRAFT:** you are able to make all the changes you wish to until the submission deadline. Please be aware that you must always submit or upgrade the status to the final version until September 26th, 2022. No abstract as draft will be considered for evaluation.

FINAL VERSION: you are not able to make any changes and your abstract is ready for evaluation.
